

Benadryl[®] Misuse and Social Media Challenges



The Trend

- Benadryl[®] is a brand name of diphenhydramine, an over-thecounter (OTC) antihistamine and sedative.
- There has been a trend in rising diphenhydramine exposures among teens aged 13-19 in recent years, particularly since 2020, likely related to the influence of social media challenges on platforms like TikTok.
- Severe symptoms including hallucinations, seizures, and cardiac problems can occur from misusing and abusing this medication.

Role of Social Media in Influencing Risky Behaviors

Social media challenges can range from fun dance routines to dangerous challenges that may cause serious harm, including poisoning. It involves a person attempting some sort of activity, filming themselves trying it, and then posting the video on a social media platform to get views, likes, or followers, along with the challenge hashtag.
